We will then make our way to **Tahquamenon Falls State Park**, to take in the many views of the upper and lower falls along trails or just shop in the gift shop or just warm up with a warm drink from the pub. We will have a delicious group pub luncheon included, and a chance to sample their brews (if you choose to, cost on your own).

We will then travel up to the Lake Superior Coastal area in Paradise Michigan to visit the Great Lakes Shipwreck Museum. Throughout the complex visitors will see maritime legends come to life, such as the Edmund Fitzgerald Exhibit. Enjoy a viewing from the Video Theatre. With climbing of steps comes spectacular views of the area. Among the buildings, is the restored Whitefish Point Light Station and the Shipwreck Coast Museum Store. Lots to do during your visit.
